The EXB-10 desktop cartridge handling subsystem (CHS) provides up to 50GB of unattended data storage. An integral robotic cartridge handling mechanism sequentially loads and unloads up to ten 8mm data cartridges. This mechanism can remove a cartridge from the drive, store it, retrieve the next cartridge, and insert it in the drive in 20 seconds.

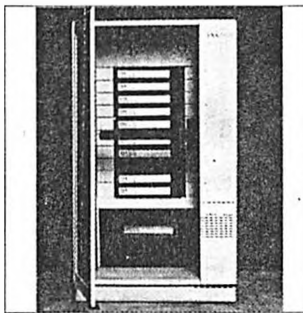
